NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE

I am writing to confirm that the Licensing Authority, acting under regulation 18(2)(b) or (c), or 19(2)(a) or (8), or 20(2)(a) or (5), of the Regulations and according to the type of medicinal product involved1, accepts your request to carry out a clinical trial in accordance with your application received on 15 September 2004 which we acknowledged in our letter dated 13 October 2004 subject to you receiving a favourable opinion from the relevant ethics committee in accordance with regulation 15(1). You may therefore carry out the trial as notified, but I must remind you of the Authority's powers under regulation 31 to suspend or terminate a clinical trial if the conditions set out in regulation 31(1)(a) and (b) are satisfied.

The authorisation is effective from the date of this letter and may continue under this authorisation. In accordance with regulation 27, you must notify the Licensing Authority within 90 days of the conclusion of the trial, that it has ended.
